















Q&A

- Q: Crash phenomenon occurred during use.
- A: Very occasionally you may experience camera freezing, crashing, colour loss and other abnormalies, this is largely due to the environment or practices that the camera is being used in. Should you experience this, please first examine whether your card is qualified. Then normal operation can be resumed by simply removing the battery, re-install then turn on the camera.
- Q: Can not operate or turn on the camera normally.
- A: First Check the battery can be charged, whether full charged or replace the backup battery and then boot up the operation.
- Q: Action camera feels hot during normal use.
- A: Because this machine is a fully sealed digital device, it will have a certain amount of heat during use, temperatures of around 45 Celsius, this is to be expected.
- Q: Sound quality is poor or there is no sound on playback.
- A: First make sure the device is not installed in the waterproof case, because the waterproof case is designed to create an air tight seal around the device preventing water ingress therefore reducing the sound that can be picked up by the microphone, ensure the microphone has not been switched off by the check menu setting options.

- Q: Video playback is not smooth, video quality it poor (blurred, Red and blue stripes).
- A: Ensure you are using a good quality class 10 (or above) Micro SD card with a capacity between 8GB-32GB, ensure the card has been correctly formatted. If the problem persists it may be necessary to format the card on the computer.
- Q: The screen prompts "Please insert SD card", but you have already inserted the SD card.
- A: You need to check whether the SD card is formatted on the camera in the first instance, if the problem persists, the file system on the SD may have become corrupted, try changing the SD card to a new class 10 SD card with capacity 8GB-32GB.
- Q: The recorded files have not saved.
- A: You need to make sure the camera is recording and the SD card is in the correct format for normal recording or replace with other SD card that meets the requirements.
- Q: The Version information of the camera I received differ with others.
- A: The Version information ONLY relates to our manufacture batches, there is no difference in function and features.



Preparation and Installation

Waterproof Case Open&Close

A. How to open the waterproof Case correctly





- To open the waterproof case, firstly take the switch on the top to right as indicated by the arrow.
- · Pull up the buckle of waterproof case.
- · Open the back cover of the waterproof case.

B. How to close the waterproof Case correctly





- To close the waterproof case. Firstly please compress the back cover of the waterproof case as arrow 1 shows.
- Please pull down the buckle, and connects it to the back cover as arrow 2 shows.
- · Pull down the buckle of the waterproof case as arrow 3 shows.

Dust-proof Cover Replacement

The camera case is supplied with two protective covers, one is waterproof, and the other is dust-proof. Please note, the dust-proof cover WILL NOT protect the camera from water ingress.

- •The waterproof protective cover is for underwater, beach, dust and other adverse environment.
- The dust-proof protective cover helps to give some protection against dust but also enhances the microphone quality whilst also reducing wind noise when riding, jogging and other sports.



- •To replace the dust proof case, first please find the slot of the waterproof case as red circled place showed in step 1.
- ·Hold the case with your hands as step 2 picture shows, face the slot on the case front, tear the waterproof back cover off.
- ·Find the dust proof back cover in your accessories, which has two inter-spaces in left and right side. Insert the lower half of the cover in the slot, then push the upper half into the slot as step 4 until the whole back cover being totally installed.

Battery Charging and Installation

The battery and the camera are packaged separately, so please make sure that the battery is charged with power, inserted into the camera before getting the camera started.


A.Battery Charging




- ·Please note the dual USB battery charger is not included in the camera's accessories. You may need purchase one if you want. Or you can charge the battery within the camera via the USB cable.
- Connect the charger with USB cable, you can charge it with power plug or withcomputer. Charging with computer may be slower than using a power adapter due to lower power output of computer USB ports.
- a. Insert the two batteries into the charging compartment. When the charger is on , the red lightwill indicate the batteries are charging, the blue light indicates the batteries are fully charged.
- b. When charging in the camera, the red light of the camera is on indicates the battery are charging, red light off means the battery is fully charged.

Normal full charging time is about 3.5 hours. Do not over charge the battery.

B.Battery Installation






- ·Find the battery compartment part in the camera. Open the battery cover as below picture shows. First, use your right thumb's fingernail to push the switch into right as arrow 1 shows. Second, lift the battery cover with your left thumb's fingernails as arrow 2 shows.
- Install the battery cover after the battery has been inserted. Please note the extended part of the battery cover should be inserted to the left of the battery compartment first as below picture shown. Then press the right half of the battery cover down into the battery compartment.

Please note the direction of the battery and battery cover.

SD Card Insertion and Formatting A. SD Card Insertion and Out



- · Find the Micro SD card slot in the camera, inserting the card into the camera as the direction and push inside.
- ·SD card out: Press down the SD card until you' ve heard a insertion sound; Then the SD card will pop out along with a pop sound.

After you insert the SD card into the camera, display shown "Please insert SD Card", then you need to format the SD card on the camera.

B. SD Card Formatting

How to format the SD card correctly?

- Insert the SD card in the state of turn off and then turn on the camera.
- •Press any key the camera will pop up "Please insert SD Card", press the power button 3-4 times to enter the menu mode.
- ·Find the "Format" setting item, select "SD card", press OK button, to complete the format.

The camera supports regular brand SD card, Class 10 or above, 8GB to 32GB, please ensure the quality of SD card.

You must format the SD card on the camera before use. If you encounter problems during formatting, just contact customer service in time.

Operation Instructions

The A66 series has four kinds of mode: Video Mode, Photo Mode, Playback Mode, Settings Mode. Below are the function instructions of each button under these modes.

Computer/TV Connecting

Computer Connecting

- There are two options when you use the included micro-USB cable to connect to a computer: Mass Storage and PC Camera. Press Up/Down button to switch between these two modes.
- Mass Storage: Access to the files which stored in camera's micro SD card to copy or view them on a computer. This function can also achieved by a micro SD card reader.
- •PC Camera: Use as a web cam for video chats and video recording on your computer. You may need to allow Adobe Flash Player to run in your video chat software before video will display.

Before pulling out the USB cable from computer, please pop out the "removable disk" on your PC first.

TV Connecting

With HDMI output, you can display the movies and images recorded by this camera on large screens of TV, projector, etc.

- ·Turn off the camera.
- •Connect the camera and TV with a commercially available Micro HDMI cable (NOT INCLUDED).
- ·Turn on the camera and turn on the HDMI setting on the device which you intended to input.

The HDMI input device should supports 1080P.

When outputting HDMI, the display of the camera turns black. The screen is displayed on the HDMI input device, but the operation is operated with the camera.
